## Mr. Cheah Cheng Hye Delivers Keynote Speech at Renowned Graham & Dodd Breakfast in New York

Mr. Cheah's speech began by introducing how Value Partners has emerged to be "a temple of value investing in Asia." Humbly offering to the audience that he might not have too much to say about the theory of value investing, he affirmed that he had vast experience in and insights into its application. Mr. Cheah explained how his team has been developing the value-investing process, adapted to the economic and investment environments in China and Asia.
