# Value Partners Young Fellowship Program Admitted University Talents in Hong Kong for Internships

(Hong Kong, 2 December 2019) — Value Partners Group Limited (Hong Kong Stock Code: 806) is pleased to announce that four young talents are admitted for 2020 internship under Value Partners Young Fellowship Program in partnership with Hong Kong University of Science and Technology ("HKUST"). Value Partners always treasures talents. Besides the fellowship program with HKUST, our group joined The University of Hong Kong Asset Management Corporate Series for their Year 2 and Year 3 students and sponsored one sharing session in January this year. Our group also participates in the Pilot Programme to Enhance Talent Training for the Asset and Wealth Management Sector ("WAM Pilot Programme") funded by the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Government and organized by the Hong Kong Securities and Investment Institute, and has been providing internships to non-final year undergraduate students in organizations of the WAM sector for three years.
